The following list shares just a few simple and loving ways to share the love.

Acts of Random Kindness

1. Offer to cook for a friend or family member.
2. Make and send a care package to someone who needs it.
3. Offer to pick up a friend or family member from work.
4. Let someone jump the queue at the supermarket.
5. Ask to pay for a coffee for them to give to someone later that day for free.
6. Pick up a few extra groceries for someone.
7. Write a thank-you note to service providers.
8. Volunteer at a nursing home.
9. Shovel snow or scrape the ice off a neighbor's windshield.
10. Help at a soup kitchen near you.
11. Pick up someone else's tab at a restaurant.
12. Leave a nice note on your coworker's desk.
13. Make a care kit with a variety of useful items to donate.
14. Give parents an evening off by babysitting for free.
15. Make a self-care basket for someone who is having a hard year.
16. Leave extra coins at a carwash, laundromat, or vending machine.

17. Offer to do your neighbor's yard work.
18. Leave positive sticky notes around the house or for a random stranger.
19. Pay the toll for the car behind you.
20. Help someone struggling to carry their grocery bags.
21. Hand out disposable water bottles to people working outside on a hot day.
22. Buy a gift card to hand to someone on your way out of the coffee shop or store.
23. Keep an extra umbrella in your car to give to someone stuck in the rain.
24. Bring treats to your local fire station.
25. Post sticky notes with uplifting messages on public bathroom mirrors.
26. Make dinner for a family in need.
27. Buy flowers to hand out on the street.
28. Leave letters of encouragement on people's cars.
29. Pack someone a lunch for the day.
30. Slip money or a gift card or a prayer in with a box of diapers.
31. Randomly text someone and compliment them.
32. Put a 'Don't Give Up' sign in your yard.
33. Leave short poems or uplifting notes on people's cars.
34. Find an extra coat in your closet and keep it in your car to give to a stranger.
